Hanyang University is one of the top universities in South Korea and was established in 1939 as the nation's first private engineering college. Hanyang is nationally renowned for its major role in development of Korea, in the destructive aftermath of Japanese occupation and Korea War. Today, Hanyang graduates can be found in virtually every industry, many serving as executives in companies including Samsung, Hyundai, and POSCO.

Hanyang University is composed of two campuses, one in central Seoul and the other in the city of Ansan on the southern outskirts of Seoul. The **Seoul Campus** is ranked **3rd** and the Ansan campus, referred to as the **ERICA* Campus** is ranked **9th** in the Joong-Ang Daily Korean University Rankings. Over the years, the Seoul Campus has been rapidly transforming to maintain its status as a top university, while the ERICA Campus has been witnessing explosive growth resulting from its specialization in university-industry cooperation.




- 2) Apostille is a certificate specifying the modalities through which a document issued in one of the signatory countries can be certified for legal purposes in all the other signatory states
- 3) Apostille convention countries abolish the complex consular procedures to ensure the mutual authentication of public and official documents (Apostilled documents have the same effect as documents verified by diplomatic offices)




